

How to use Word champ's Web-Reader

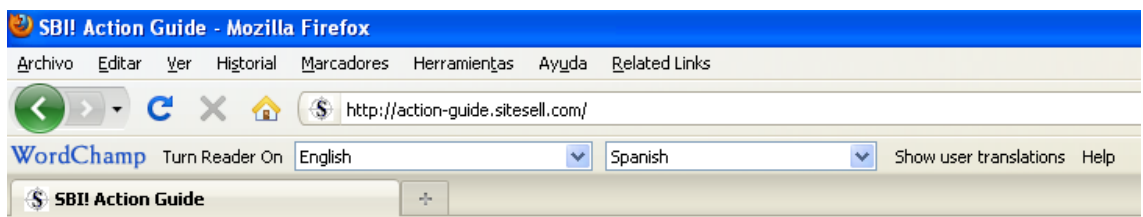

- Just go to www.wordchamp.com
- In the horizontal navigation bar you will see, Home...Flashcards, Absolute Recall and **Web Reader...**
- Click on webreader and then select the dropdown menu that says, "Download the WordChamp Lanugage Toolbar".
- Agree to their terms of use and click "download toolbar".
- Then, when it is downloaded, just restart Firefox and you will see the bar in your browser (like below).

Here is what the bar looks like:



Here is how it looks in Firefox:

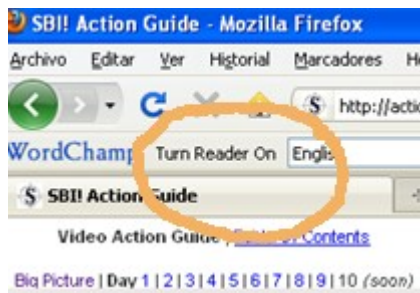
Then to use the web reader just navigate to the webpage that you want to read...for example: <http://action-guide.sitesell.com/>.

Select the languages that you want to use.

For example SBI is in English so the first language should be English, and your native language should be in the second section (in this case probably Spanish).

Then you just have to turn the reader on.

Click, “turn on reader”.



It might take a couple of seconds to load but the page will look exactly the same but the tool will be active.

Now take you mouse and hover it over a word you don't understand... for example “welcome”.

Below you will see how the web reader works.



When you put your cursor over a word, a window opens and offers you the English words (with audio) and the Spanish translation.

If there aren't any definitions then you can see there are hyperlinks to send you to WordChamp for further help or Wikipedia as well.
